### Sri Lanka Market Report

**MARKET REPORT : SALE NO. 05 - 31<sup>ST</sup> JANUARY / 01<sup>ST</sup> FEBRUARY 2012**

#### Western Teas

Select best BOPs advanced Rs. 10/- to Rs. 20/- following special inquiry, other good invoices were irregularly lower, below best sorts were firm to irregular, plainer varieties were firm to easier. Select best BOPFs were firm, other good invoices shed Rs. 10/- 20 Rs. 20/-, below best and plainer varieties gained Rs. 5/- to Rs. 10/- and eased as the sale progressed. Medium BOPs shed Rs. 10/- to Rs. 20/- whilst the BOPFs declined Rs. 5/- to Rs. 10/-.

#### Nuwara Eliya Teas

BOPs were barely steady. BOPFs declined Rs. 10/- to Rs. 20/- on average.

#### Uva Teas

BOPs were irregularly lower. BOPFs shed Rs. 10/- to Rs. 15/-. Uda Pussellawa BOPs declined Rs. 10/-. BOPFs shed Rs. 15/- to Rs. 20/- on average.

#### CTC Teas

Low Grown PF1 / BP1s declined Rs. 10/- to Rs. 15/-. A few High & Medium PF1s sold well on special inquiry, others were irregular following quality. BP1s shed Rs. 10/- to Rs. 20/- on average.

#### Low Grown

Good demand. Select best along with the best OP1s maintained last levels, below best types gained Rs. 5/- to Rs. 10/- and more following quality, clean poor types too gained Rs. 5/- to Rs. 10/- whilst balance were steady. Select best BOP1s were irregularly dearer by Rs. 5/- to Rs. 10/-, clean best varieties too gained Rs. 10/- to Rs. 15/- whilst the balance eased Rs. 5/- to Rs. 10/-, below best and poor types were irregular. Select best OPs maintained last levels, best types were fully firm, below best and poor types gained Rs. 5/- to Rs. 10/-. Select best OPAs shed Rs. 5/- to Rs. 10/-, best types were firm, below best and poor sorts gained Rs. 5/- to Rs. 10/-. Select best Pekoe / Pekoe1s were steady, bold Pekoe varieties appreciated Rs. 5/- to Rs. 10/-, poor types to gained Rs. 3/- to Rs. 5/-. However lower demand for Tippy small leaf varieties. Select best and best BOP/BOP.SP.s shed Rs. 10/- to Rs. 15/-, below best and poorer sorts too were lower by Rs. 5/- to Rs. 10/-. Select best and best FBOP/FBOPF1s declined Rs. 20/- and at times more as the sale progressed, below best and poor sorts also declined by a similar margin. Select best and best tippy sorts were substantially lower to last, below best and poor sorts too were much lower to last.

#### Off Grades

Select best and best liquoring FNGS1s depreciated Rs. 10/- to Rs. 15/- whilst the below best and poorer sorts were lower by Rs. 20/- and more at times. Select best and best BMs were firm to dearer by Rs. 10/- whilst the below best and poorer sorts appreciated Rs. 10/-. All Low Grown Fngs were dearer by Rs. 20/-. All BPs appreciated Rs. 10/- and more at times. Select best BOP1As were firm to dearer by Rs.5/- to Rs.10/-, best and below best were steady on last levels, poorer sorts however, were irregularly lower to last and continued declining as the sale progressed.

#### Dust

Select best Dust1s appreciated Rs. 5/- to Rs. 10/- whilst the best and below best types declined Rs. 10/- to Rs. 15/- and more at times, poorer sorts declined further. Clean secondaries shed Rs. 10/- to Rs. 15/- whilst the below best types declined further, poorer sorts remained firm. Best Low Grown Dust / Dust1s maintained last levels whilst the below best types advanced Rs. 15/- to Rs. 20/-, poorer sorts were irregular and mostly lower.
